3. What are Kerrie Snow's primary responsibilities as Aid Sudan's Director of Health?

Working from Aid Sudan's office in Kampala, Uganda, Kerrie's responsibilities as Director of Health will be two-fold. First, she will launch Aid Sudan's Philip Project, which involves training and equipping Ugandan missionaries to travel into Sudan to serve southern Sudanese communities. Kerrie's training will focus primarily on health and hygiene, as well as spiritual development. Secondly, Kerrie will lead and facilitate mission teams, particularly those serving through medical missions.

4. How long will Kerrie work and live in Uganda?

Kerrie's commitment at this time is for two years, followed by a two-month furlough.

5. Why will Kerrie live in Uganda and not southern Sudan?

Kerrie will be training Ugandans to go into Sudan and will be working with Kerry Henderson to facilitate medical mission teams who will go into Sudan. Additionally, more resources are available in Uganda than in southern Sudan.

6. What is the current status of health care in southern Sudan?

Health care in some areas of southern Sudan is almost non-existent. The areas that do have some health care are very limited and usually have next to no resources available. Staff in existing clinics have little or no training.
